



## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

We believe sailing should be accessible to all, regardless of financial means. In establishing this scholarship fund at Deep Creek Landing Marina & Coastal Shores Inc., we hope to introduce the joys of sailing to all children in the Hampton Roads area.

Applicants for the scholarship must be ages 5 to 12 years of age, live in the Hampton Roads area, have a passion for life on or around the sea, and must be able to pass our swim test. If your child - or a child you know – is interested in joining summer camp at Deep Creek Landing Marina, but may not be able to afford full tuition, you may apply for a scholarship by filling out the application. We will review the scholarship requests on a case-by-case basis and reserve the right to award this scholarship based on its sole discretion.

All applicants should complete this form and return it together with the parent and student letters to Deep Creek Landing Marina, 200 Old Marina Lane, Newport News, VA 23602 or email to [dcl@deepcreeklanding.com](mailto:dcl@deepcreeklanding.com). To award a scholarship, we require the following:

- **Parent Letter/Financial Need:** This scholarship is provided based upon demonstrated financial need. Parent(s)/guardian(s) must provide a confidential letter stating the reasons why the student should receive a scholarship to attend summer camp.
- **Student Intent Letter:** The student must provide a letter explaining their reasons for wishing to participate in Deep Creek Landing Marina/Coastal Shore's summer camp (all students are encouraged to write this themselves).
- **Post Summer Camp Letter:** If your student receives the scholarship, Deep Creek Landing Marina/Coastal Shores would like the student, at the end of summer camp, to provide a letter describing the student's favorite parts of the program, what they learned and if/why they would like to come back next summer.
- **Swimming Requirement:** All students must be able to swim 25-50 yards and tread water for 3 minutes, without the aid of a life jacket (except ages 5-7, they must wear a life jacket while conducting the swim test). This will be tested on the first day of class.
